Research Analysis

The policy committee recommendation for HB 3552 provides that a licensed or permitted childcare provider servicing a child eligible for the Child Care Subsidy Program may charge the parent or guardian the difference between the subsidy reimbursement rate applicable to the child and the provider's standard private tuition rate, upon approval by the Administration for Children and Families. The Department of Human Services must not penalize a provider for charging a differential or take adverse action against a provider solely for charging a differential. Providers who charge a differential must apply it uniformly to all similarly situated families. The Department must promulgate rules and other actions needed to comply with this measure.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3552 allows childcare providers who are eligible for the Department of Human Services' (DHS) Child Care Subsidy Program to charge a differential fee. Implementation of the measure is contingent upon federal approval by the Administration for Children and Families (ACF). In its current form, HB 3552 is not expected to have a fiscal impact on the state budget.
