Research Analysis

HB 3568 as introduced, requires advocacy organizations, political parties, elected officials, and registered candidates who give or receive anything of value over \$100 per year to submit a disclosure report with the Oklahoma Ethics Commission. This requirement is extended to advocacy organizations or political parties that give over \$100 to immediate family members of elected state or local officials and registered candidates. Violations of this provision can result in civil penalties or criminal prosecution.

Fiscal Analysis

House Bill 3568 creates new law requiring a change request with CIVIX, the vendor responsible for the Ethics Commission Campaign Finance Reporting System. Implementation of the measure would also require additional staff to offset increased administrative workload at the Ethics Commission. Associated implementation costs are expected to be approximately \$62,500 per fiscal year.
