**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 3619 requires the State Geographic Information Council to create a workgroup that establishes authoritative county boundaries. Further, the Office of Geographic Information is required to regularly conduct leaf-off aerial imagery to update the county boundary data layer, and recertify it annually. Lastly the measure modifies membership to the State Geographic Information Council and removes mention of maps.ok.gov website.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 3619 requires the Office of Geographic Information, housed within the Oklahoma Conservation Commission, to biennially or annually conduct leaf-off aerial imagery to update authoritative jurisdictional county boundary data, subject to the availability of funds. The Conservation Commission estimates that the cost to conduct full-state aerial imagery to be One Million, Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00). This impact would require additional appropriated funding to go to the agency during the years the imagery is conducted.
