HB 3648 as introduced, amends the definition of *public trust* as it relates to the Governmental Tort Claims Act to include university hospitals trust and any sole member non-profit corporation of the public trust and any sole member non-profit subsidiary of such corporation.

Fiscal Analysis

House Bill 3648 amends the Governmental Tort Claims Act to clarify that employees of certain sole-member nonprofit corporations and their subsidiaries associated with a public trust are considered employees for purposes of the Act. The amendatory language is strictly definitional in nature. Any additional legal or administrative duties are expected to be absorbed within existing agency resources. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
