**Research Analysis**

HB 3659, as introduced, limits nonresident waterfowl hunting on all public land south of Interstate 40 and east of Interstate 35 on Monday to Thursday. This measure prohibits nonresident waterfowl hunting on public land Friday through Sunday during the last thirty days of the season if there is no split in the season. This measure also increases fines for violating this section.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3659 adds additional restrictions on nonresidents who hunt waterfowl as well as raises the fine for violation of this statute to five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Any additional fine revenue generated by these modifications would be directed to the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation. Upon review, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations on state budgetary resources.
