**Research Analysis**

HB 3711, as introduced, requires school districts to publish the percent of their expenditures that goes towards instruction on the home page of their website. Further, when a district calls for a bond election, it must also publish the percent of their expenditures that goes towards instruction on their website along with other information about the bond proposal. Lastly, districts must include such information on any bond guarantee application filed with the Commissioners of the Land Office.
