Research Analysis

HB 3727 as introduced, prohibits a political subdivision from spending funds to hire a lobbyist or to pay a nonprofit state association or organization to lobby on their behalf. If a political subdivision violates these provisions, a taxpayer or resident can file suit against the subdivision and they are entitled to injunctive relief and attorney's fees and costs should they prevail. The measure also prohibits former members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma State Senate from working or registering as a lobbyist for six years after the expiration of their last term beginning January 1, 2027. Any members who are currently registered lobbyists, are to be ineligible for registration renewal until six years after their last term expired.
