Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute to HB 3727 prohibits former members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma State Senate from working or registering as a lobbyist for four years after the expiration of their last term beginning November 1, 2026. The provisions of this measure will not apply to any former legislators who become registered lobbyists before November 1, 2026.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 3727 creates new law relating to eligibility for certain former legislators to register as lobbyists. The measure does not appropriate state funds, increase administrative workload, or alter revenue sources. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
