HB 3787 as introduced, prohibits anyone who is not a natural born citizen of the U.S. from holding an elected municipal, county, state, or other governmental office in Oklahoma.

Fiscal Analysis

House Bill 3787 limits eligibility to hold elected office by prohibiting persons who are not natural-born U.S. citizens from serving. The measure does not authorize new spending, increase agency obligations, or change revenues. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
