**Research Analysis**

HB 3852 as introduced, reduces the terms for precinct inspectors, judges, and clerks from four years to two years. Additionally, the measure reduces the number of precinct official nominees provided by the county central committees from three times to two times the number of precincts in the county. If the list of nominees does not meet the required number, the secretary of the county election board must still appoint officials from the provided list unless the nominee isn't willing to serve or doesn't meet certain qualifications.

**Fiscal Analysis**

House Bill 3852 amends election statutes by modifying certain election-related procedures. The measure does not mandate additional elections or include appropriation language, and any associated administrative costs are expected to be absorbed within existing budgetary resources. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the statue budget or appropriations.
