**Research Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 3885 subjects students in grades 3-5 to suspension for injuring a school employee or volunteer. A student's first offense in a school year requires a 3-day in-school suspension; Second offense requires a 7-day out-of-school suspension; and a third offense in a school year will result in expulsion. The term of the suspension may be modified by the district superintendent on a case-by-case basis.
