Fiscal Analysis

The CS to HB3903 directs law enforcement agencies to prepare written domestic violence incident reports, requires court clerks to accept for filing and maintain all protective order petitions as part of case records, and mandates that each member of the judiciary who hears criminal, juvenile, family, and domestic cases complete no fewer than two hours of domestic violence training every two years. Any costs associated with the enhanced reporting requirements for law enforcement, additional filing and record maintenance duties for court clerks, and mandatory judicial training are expected to be absorbed in accordance with the normal duties of the agencies involved. Therefore, in its current form, the CS to HB3903 is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
