Research Analysis

HB 4109 requires medical personnel or employees of medical institutions to report any treatment of individuals with wounds, injuries, or illnesses caused by firearms, sharp instruments, poisoning, incendiary or explosive devices, or any suspicious or violent actions to the local police or county sheriff immediately. The report should include patient details and any information helpful for investigation, such as videos of the incident. Video and other records must be provided within 72 hours. The measure provides immunity from civil liability to the person making the report and exempts the report from the public record.

Garage keepers or employees who find evidence of a crime, such as bullet marks, blood stains, or other crime marks on motor vehicles, must report it immediately to local law enforcement, the county sheriff, or the Oklahoma Highway Patrol.

Failure to report is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to \$500, imprisonment in the county jail for up to 6 months, or both fine and imprisonment.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure creates new law directing certain persons to immediately report various potentially crime related incidents and/or details to law enforcement, and sets forth guidelines on doing so. Persons who fail to do so as required by these provisions shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed 6 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any resulting change to the revenues collected by the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) or change in the costs incurred by the Department of Corrections (DOC) are expected to be immaterial and/or absorbed by the agencies. Therefore, this measure in its current form is anticipated to be budget neutral.
