Research Analysis

HB 4140 increases the penalty for grand larceny if the property is one or more firearms from a Class D3 felony offense to a Class C2 felony offense. The penalty for accepting stolen property if the property is one or more firearm is classified as a Class C2 felony offense.

Any person convicted of a Class C2 criminal offense shall be punished by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term of not more than seven years and shall serve at least twenty percent of the sentence imposed before release from custody.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure amends felony grand larceny crimes to include when the property is one or more firearms. Persons convicted of such offenses shall be guilty of a Class C2 felony offense and shall be punished by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections (DOC) for a term of not more than 7 years and shall serve at least 20% of the sentence imposed, or by a fine not to exceed \$1,000, or by both such fine and imprisonment. The frequency of a new crime cannot be predicted, however any resulting change to the revenues collected by the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) or change in the costs incurred by the Department of Corrections (DOC) are expected to be immaterial and/or absorbed by the agencies. Therefore, this measure in its current form is anticipated to be budget neutral.
