Research Analysis

HB 4147, as introduced, clarifies language pertaining to professional trappers. This measure provides that landowners or lessees shall not be limited in the number of snares used to trap coyotes or feral hogs and that no license shall not be required for such actions. This measure also sets fines for violating the provisions of this subsection.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 4147 clarifies that a license is not required for landowners or lessees of agricultural land to use snares to trap coyotes and feral hogs upon their land year-round and adds a potential fine for violation of this statute. Upon review, this measure had no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
