Research Analysis

HB 4153 establishes an eighth-grade reading proficiency requirement for minors in Oklahoma to obtain a driver license or permit. It outlines testing criteria, documentation, exceptions, and enforcement. Persons under 18 must demonstrate reading ability at an eighth-grade level by passing the statewide reading assessment or an approved alternative test to qualify for a driver license or permit. Students with an Individualized Education Program related to reading may provide alternative documentation of proficiency.
