**Research Analysis**

HB 4274, as introduced, modifies state law regarding military student school transfers. The measure clarifies that students who are the dependents of parents on active-duty military service are eligible for admission to the school district of their choice regardless of capacity. Such students must be treated by the receiving district as residing within the district for enrollment purposes. Lastly, the measure clarifies that the parent of a student who is transferring in to the state on military orders must show proof of living in the state within 10 days of published arrival date.
