Research Analysis

HB 4324 authorizes the district attorney to adjust the sentence of an individual at any time after the initial sentencing. The district attorney may not seek to increase the term of confinement or increase the period of supervision. The district attorney is to consider input from the victim. Upon filing a motion to adjust the sentence, the court may consider postconviction factors. The district attorney can not seek readjustment of sentences of death, life without the possibility of parole, or any offense which requires registration under the Sex Offenders Registration Act.
