Research Analysis

The amendment to the policy recommendation for HB 4454 removes the cap on the amount of THC per serving that edible and beverage products containing THC can have. It also removes the prohibition on color additives in edible medical marijuana products.

HB 4454 requires that edible medical marijuana products and those intended to be consumed as a drink clearly indicate the number of servings of THC in each package and the amount of THC in each individual serving. Edible medical marijuana products must not be attractive to children, be made in the shape of humans, cartoons or animals, or be made in a form of commercially available candy.
