Research Analysis

HB 4460, as introduced, provides that health plans issuing commercially insured products and benefits be solely responsible for collecting the patient cost-sharing amounts directly from enrollees. Health plans cannot cancel or terminate coverage or impose penalties due to nonpayment of cost-sharing obligations. Health plans must meet all state timely payment requirements for payment to the provider. Health plans must also provide enrollees with affordable payment plans for cost-amounts owed and due under the terms of their benefits. Health plans must pay full in-network or out-of-network allowable amounts in a timely manner, whether or not the cost-share has been paid and health plans cannot contractually require clinicians to collect cost-sharing amounts. Health plans found to violate this will be subject to penalties.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 4460 establishes requirements for health plans related to collecting enrollee cost-sharing and making timely payments to providers.
