Research Analysis

SB 37 provides that the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation may respond to a mass casualty event caused by a violent crime without a request from local law enforcement. The measure defines mass casualty event and creates the Mass Casualty Revolving Fund.

Fiscal Analysis

The Engrossed version of SB37 provides that the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) may respond to a "mass casualty event" as such an event is defined within the measure. The measure also creates a revolving fund for OSBI to be designated the "Mass Casualty Revolving Fund." The fund shall consist of all monies received by OSBI from legislative appropriations, federal grants, or funds from any other source provided for the purpose of investigating mass casualty events and such funds are to be budgeted and expended by OSBI for the purposes provided for in the act. In its current form, SB37 sets forth permissive language for OSBI to act after certain events, and creates a fund without specifying funding mechanisms. Therefore, there is no direct fiscal impact as a result of the measure, however the agency may seek funding mechanisms in the future.
