Research Analysis

The committee substitute to SB 652 modifies the date for elections currently held in September from the second Tuesday of September to the third Tuesday of June in any year. The date for elections in November has been updated from the second Tuesday of November to the fourth Tuesday of August in any year. The date for elections in June have been updated from the second Tuesday of June to the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November in any year. Additionally, the measure allows for elections to be held on the second Tuesday of December beginning in December of 2025 and every four years thereafter rather than only in odd numbered years.

The measure further provides exceptions for when the Governor can call a special election outside of the regular election dates, and provides specific circumstances under which additional dates are allowed, and provides dates on which the election can be held. The provisions of this measure will apply to elections held after January 1, 2026.

Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to SB 652 does not materially alter the prior fiscal impact statement. The measure modifies certain election dates and provides special election exceptions under certain circumstances. The cost for implementation of the measure is anticipated to be minimal and absorbed by existing agency resources at the State Election Board.
