**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for SB 662 requires the Oklahoma Workforce Commission to implement programs to develop the workforce in high-demand or critical occupations, work-based learning opportunities, and innovation in public schools for workforce success. The programs may be administered through the newly created Oklahoma Workforce Commission Revolving Fund. The commission must also serve as the centralized data repository for the state's workforce development activities and provide data for the Legislature's interactive [Workforce & Infrastructure Working Group map](#).

**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to SB 662 requires the Oklahoma Workforce Commission to implement particular workforce development programs and allows the Commission to utilize the Workforce Coordination Revolving Fund to administer these programs. This measure also creates the Oklahoma Workforce Commission Revolving Fund, but appropriates no new monies to the fund. Therefore, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state as written.
