**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB 674 requires any charter school that is formed and operated under the provisions of the Oklahoma Charter Schools Act and sponsored by the Statewide Charter School Board to submit a charter school site plan to the appropriate municipal governing body after acquiring a building not currently zoned for use as an education building. The charter school site plan must include information demonstrating intention to utilize the building as a charter school for at least the next five years and details on how the building might be altered.

Any business or entity with a location restriction by a distance requirement to a school will not be deemed in violation of the distance restriction if a charter school is approved pursuant to the provisions of this measure.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Engrossed SB 674 requires charter schools to submit site plans to the appropriate municipal governing bodies under certain circumstances.
