Research Analysis

The conference committee report to SB 676 recedes from the House amendment and adopts the conference committee substitute.

SB 676, as amended, establishes the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services as the only agency involved in implementing the Suicide Prevention Act and allows the Department to submit their annual evaluation report electronically to the Governor and Legislative Leadership. Additionally, the measure extends the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering until July 1, 2026.

Lastly, the measure repeals several sections of law including:

- <u>Title 2 Sections 16-35</u>, <u>16-36</u>, <u>16-37</u>, and <u>16-38</u>, which relate to South Central Interstate Forest Fire Protection Compact;
- <u>Title 43A Section 12-104</u>, which relates to the Oklahoma Suicide Prevention Council;
- <u>Title 62 Section 34.30</u>, which relates to the Electronic and Information Technology Accessibility Advisory Council;
- <u>Title 70 Sections 1210.451, 1210.452, and 1210.453</u>, which relate to the Oklahoma School for the Visual and Performing Arts;
- <u>Title 73 Section 176</u>, which relates to the Permanent Legislative Liaison Committee;
- <u>Title 74 Sections 291.10</u>, <u>291.11</u>, and <u>291.19</u>, which relate to Staff Review Committee of the Senate; and
- <u>Title 74 Section 840-1.7</u>, which relates to the Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission.
