Research Analysis

The committee substitute to SB 68 adds the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the District Attorneys Council, the Office of the Attorney General, and the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector to the definition of *state agency* as it relates to the Information Technology Consolidation and Coordination Act. The measure also establishes that state agencies, including those added to the definition, may employ information technology personnel to develop and implement the agency's technology strategy. Before hiring information technology personnel, the state agency must enter into a memorandum of understanding with the Chief Information Officer of the state to ensure data integrity and security. Additionally, the title is restored to the measure.

Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to SB 68 authorizes certain agencies to employ information technology personnel pursuant to the Information Technology Consolidation and Coordination Act. The measure uses permissive language such that action or expenditure by a state agency is not mandated. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
