Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 770 modifies membership of the Commission for Rehabilitation Services to increase the Commission from three members to seven members, three of which will be appointed by the Governor and two each appointed by Senate and House leaders. Members will be appointed for three terms, each of which will begin on July 1 and end on June 30. Current appointees will serve until the dates listed in the measure and new members will serve shorter terms to increase the commission membership as directed in the schedule in the measure.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 770 expands the membership of the Commission for Rehabilitation Services from three (3) to seven (7) members. All members serve without compensation; however, they are reimbursed for expenses incurred in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

Therefore, the fiscal considerations for the state are contingent upon the travel expenses incurred by the Commission each year; however, it is anticipated to be minimal, if any.
