Bill Analysis

HB 1095 creates the Municipal Carry Act. The measure allows the governing body of a municipality or town to authorize the concealed carry of handguns into any building or office space that is owned or leased by a city or town. Such authorization shall not extend to any courthouse, courtroom, prison, jail, detention facility, or any facility used to process, hold, or house arrested persons. The measure also authorizes municipal judges who possess a valid handgun license to carry a firearm when acting in the scope of their duties. Elected officials of a municipality are also authorized to carry firearms into buildings or offices owned or leased by the municipality.
