Bill Analysis

HB 1460 removes the \$5.00 fee owed to the court for any person found guilty of misdemeanor possession of marijuana or drug paraphernalia. The measure also eliminates the reimbursement owed to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation as well as the \$300.00 electronic monitoring fee for persons receiving suspended sentences. The measure authorizes the court to waive the \$40.00 fee owed to the district attorney and provides that any unpaid costs of prosecution shall be waived if the suspended sentence of an offender expires without being revoked. The measure eliminates the \$15.00 fee assessed in every misdemeanor or felony case for each offense of driving under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicating substance as well as the \$100.00 assessment allocated to the Drug Abuse Education and Treatment Revolving Fund.
