**Bill Analysis**

SB 1043 modifies the membership of the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision. The measure decreases the number of allopathic physicians on the Board from 7 to 5, decreases the number of lay appointees to the Board from 4 to 2, and adds 2 physician assistants to the Board. The measure also provides that the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and Speaker of the House shall each appoint 2 members to the Board. The measure also strikes language requiring the Governor to only nominate allopathic physicians to the Board using a list of nominees submitted by the Oklahoma State Medical Association.
