Bill Analysis

SB 1046 creates a delivery services license for retailers, restaurants, clubs, grocery stores, convenience stores, and bars and the employees of such businesses. The measure establishes an annual fee of \$10,000.00 for the Delivery Service License for the businesses and \$30.00 for the Delivery Driver License. The measure provides that the actions of a driver or server shall not be attributable to the retailer, restaurant, club, grocery store, convenience store, and bar with regard to providing alcohol to a minor or delivery of alcohol into a dry area. The measure provides that a retailer, restaurant, bar, or club holding a mixed beverage, beer and wine, or caterer/mixed beverage license shall not be required to verify the delivery service licensee has received delivery driver training or a delivery driver license. No delivery driver or delivery service licensee shall provide free delivery of alcoholic beverage products. The measure requires any order containing alcoholic beverage products to have an independent delivery fee of \$15.00 or 15%, whichever is greater. The measure requires \$1.00 of this fee to be remitted to the ABLE Commission. No delivery may be left unattended at a resident or business address except for the delivery of such alcoholic beverage products in person to the purchaser.
