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Bill Analysis

SB 1190 requires school districts beginning with the 2026-2027 school year to designate a minimum of 1 day as industry day for ninth through twelfth grade students to explore career opportunities available at industries in the state. The measure directs districts to collaborate with employers, career and technology center schools, and institutions of higher education located in or around the district to provide information to students. It also allows a district's industry day to be incorporated as part of the Individual Career and Academic Plan process, include information about apprenticeships, internships, and mentorships, and be coordinated with the Work-based Learning Program established by the Governor's Council for Workforce and Economic Development.

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
