Bill Analysis

SB 1247 prohibits an individual who is not lawfully present in the United States from being eligible on the basis of residence for any postsecondary education benefits or resident tuition. It removes outdated language. The measure repeals a section of law that provides circumstances under which a student could be eligible for resident tuition if the student could provide certain documentation.
