**Bill Analysis**

SB 1311 creates the Railroad Crossing Transparency and Safety Accountability Act. The measure directs the Rail Programs Division of the Department of Transportation to annually compile and review statewide railroad-crossing safety data. Such data shall include accidents, traffic volume, characteristics and crossings, safety assessments, hazard index calculations and any related federal ranking methodologies, and other data as needed. The measure directs the Division to annually submit the report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor. The report shall be made publicly available no more than 30 days after the submission of the report.
