**Bill Analysis**

SB 1488 establishes a moratorium on building data centers in the state until November 1, 2029. The measure directs the Corporation Commission to conduct a study on the potential impacts that data centers might have on the water supply, utility rates, property values, and other areas deemed of interest by the Commission. The Commission shall also conduct a study on the ideal siting of such centers in the state. The Commission is directed to submit a report of the study findings to the Legislature and include recommendations for regulating data centers as well as the sourcing of data center components.
