**Bill Analysis**

SB 179 provides that all state agencies shall be responsible for their information technology services and directs the Information Services Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to transfer all data, records, and other information regarding the agency's information technology and cybersecurity services by the effective date. The measure also provides that all cybersecurity duties shall be maintained by the Information Services Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services repeals provisions of law relating to the Division. The measure repeals the Information Technology Consolidation and Coordination Act.
