**Bill Analysis**

SB 1792 modifies training requirements for school board members. The measure provides that such training shall be optional and provides that such training shall only be provided in school finance, Oklahoma Open Meeting compliance, and school law and ethics. Each topic shall be taught for 1 hour. The measure requires each member of the board to represent the interests of his or her constituents and hold the school district superintendent to the same. The measure repeals language relating to continuing education requirements for school board members.
