Bill Analysis

SB 1879 specifies that a voter must meet certain qualifications to apply for an absentee ballot, excluding in-person absentee ballots. Such a person must be employed outside of the jurisdiction holding the election, have a physical illness which prevents his or her attendance, must be primarily responsible for the physical care of a person with a physical illness, a member of or spouse of the Armed Forces, or deployed as a first responder.
