**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB 1575 directs DHS to conduct a feasibility study and request for information on a unified and streamlined eligibility and enrollment system for programs including but not limited to: SNAP, TANF, LIHEAP, WIC, Child Care Subsidy, and Medicaid.

The measure also requires the agency to submit a report to the Senate, House, and Governor on the study and cost to implement the streamlined system.

The cost of this study will be minimal and can be absorbed by the agency.
