**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

This bill creates the Protecting Oklahoma's Children on Social Media Act of 2025. It directs the State Department of Education by the start of the 2025-26 school year to develop a comprehensive character education program focusing on certain traits, such as character, patriotism, tolerance, punctuality, cleanliness, sportsmanship, and virtue.

The fiscal impact would include the salary for an OSDE staff member to create the materials and facilitate workshops. In the current form of the bill, districts would not need to purchase materials if the Department creates and provides the materials. Districts may need to use funds to print or purchase materials related to the curriculum.
