### Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 1284 states that no person may perform as an exotic dancer in Oklahoma without obtaining an exotic entertainer license issued by the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission. The license will be renewed annually. The measure creates new misdemeanor offenses for people performing without a valid license. Any operator who violates the provisions of the measure will be guilty of a felony subject to a maximum \$1,000 fine and/or a term of imprisonment of 2-5 years.

The fiscal impact of the measure is \$1,537,354 for the first year of implementation with costs related to updating the software and acquiring new vehicles, equipment, and FTEs to carry out the provisions of the measure. The fiscal impact every year thereafter is \$1,110,354. The fiscal impact of the measure will be reduced by the cost to obtain and renew the license.
