**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB1289 increases all state employee wages, with some specified employee category exceptions, by 5%. Part-time employees shall receive a prorated increase.

Based on current state employee wages, the bill would have an impact of \$96,967,338 in FY'27. The impact will be a recurring impact, likely altering slightly annually due to employment variances.
