**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1360 directs OSDE to establish a three-year pilot program to utilize mathematics instructional teams to support districts to implement the Oklahoma Math Achievement and Proficiency Act, and updates other statutes for a school year of 181 days, or 1,866 instructional hours.

SDE reports that there are 509 total school districts. The measure will provide math coaches to a percentage of school districts with the lowest math assessment scores conducted each year of the pilot. The percentage of schools receiving this assistance would increase each year of the program, from 10% in year one, to 20% in year two, and finally 30% in year three. It is anticipated that each math coach will create a recurring annual impact of \$122,726. In the first year, 51 districts will receive assistance creating a total impact of \$6,259,026. In the second year the impact increases to \$12,518,052 for 102 districts, and \$18,777,078 in year three for 153 districts.
