**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1543 states that the conviction of a second act of driving under the influence within a 1-year period will be classified as a Class C2 offense. People convicted of this crime will be guilty of a felony and subject to an assessment and evaluation plan in addition to other penalties as provided for in current law. A maximum fine of \$2,500 is also established by the measure.

The Department of Corrections notes any incarceration increases would be dependent on the number of future convictions, and the agency is unable to determine a fiscal impact. The Department has provided the marginal/incremental cost of an incarcerated inmate, which is \$67.26 per day or \$24,549.90 per year.
