**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1566 expands the medical necessity criteria for applied behavior analysis (ABA) services for Medicaid enrollees to include a diagnosis of an autism spectrum disorder by certain health care providers. The measure also allows the usage of telehealth to provide certain services by a board-certified assistant behavior analyst (BCABA).

OHCA estimates that this change will result in a need for additional staff/administrative expense of \$350,000 annually.
