**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB1700 directs the Purchasing Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to create a State Purchasing Portal.

OMES anticipates an annual impact of \$1,000,000-\$1,500,000 annually required to pay for the creation and maintenance of the portal and would require at least 1 additional FTE to review submitted documentation to verify accuracy and sufficiency before posting. For other agencies, this will double the administrative requirements for making a purchase. OMES estimates that there would be an increase in necessary head count to agencies' finance departments resulting in over \$1,000,000 in salaries annually. The FY'27 impact is halved given the implementation date of January.
