**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 176 requires any health benefit plan providing coverage for contraceptives to offer enrollees coverage for a 3-month supply of a contraceptive drug the first time the enrollee obtains the drug, and a 12-month supply of the contraceptive drug at once each subsequent time that the enrollee obtains the same drug.

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) estimates a fiscal impact of \$250,000 to HealthChoice.
