**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1767 authorizes the Attorney General to bring civil actions in federal district court and state court to seek injunctive relief if any person or retailer ships alcoholic beverages in the state or receives payments for fulfilling any orders not authorized by law. The ABLE Commission is authorized to investigate and assist the Attorney General. The proposal creates the Alcohol Enforcement and Regulatory Revolving Fund.

The ABLE Commission estimates at least \$250,000 for additional staff to implement the provisions of this measure for at least two agents and one part-time legal staffer. The Office of the Attorney General does not estimate a fiscal impact.
