**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1859 establishes the Cyber Crime and Fraud Unit within the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation. This unit will investigate criminal activity and financial fraud that involves digital evidence. Investigations within this unit can only be done at the request of a district attorney, a law enforcement agency, the governor, or a state law enforcement officer.

OSBI anticipates a cost of \$3,500,000 to comply with the provisions of the measure. This includes a one-time cost of \$500,000 for new computers, vehicles, weapons, and other equipment and an annual recurring cost of \$3,000,000 for FTEs, training, and software licenses.
