**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1909 requires all proceedings under the Oklahoma Children's Code that require a medical evaluator to use a randomized selection process for medical evaluators. The measure directs the Office of the Administrative Director of the Courts to establish the selection process as well as an audit system that documents all interactions between the Department of Human Services personnel and medical professionals. The Attorney General is directed to investigate any violations of the selection process and to bring civil actions or prosecutions against those that do not comply with the provisions of the measure.

The fiscal impact of the measure is \$202,482, comprised of \$102,482 for the salary and benefits of a new AOC employee to oversee the provisions of the measure and a \$100,000 professional contract for medical services. The FY'27 fiscal impact is \$134,988, prorated based on 8 months given the effective date of November 1st, 2026. The fiscal impact every year thereafter is \$202,482.
